02/12/102 East Riding of Yorkshire Council Matters

(a) Highways

Fence on Elm Drive

The situation has now been resolved and the fence has been removed.

Rootas Lane

Cllr Pollard had liaised with Steve Charlton at ERYC. They will not remove the spoil at the side of the road, but they will contact the farmer who allegedly put it there and make him remove it.

Some names were suggested to Cllr Pollard.

Resolved – Cllr Pollard to pass the names on the ERYC.

Pond

Although some bricks from the pile next to the Village Green had been thrown into the icy pond, the pile has now been removed.

Gritting

Cllr Morton commented that the slope at the Cedar Grange end of The Meadows had been gritted, which had been appreciated by the local residents.

(b) Flooding

CREATE have written a letter bringing up some concerns about the completed flood prevention work. They would like to add the Parish Council's name to the letter and there was a discussion.

Cllr Peirson brought up the modelling that was proposed for the defences and asked why it was not done before the work.

He was also concerned about the Parish Council being liable for maintenance of the barrier.

Cllr Smith has inspected the works and has had positive comments from other residents. He had been informed that there had been changes as the work went on and thought the perhaps the modelling would be because of this.

It was agreed that the Parish Council response to the letter would be:-
“We note these points and would draw particular attention to paragraphs 7 and 9.”

Cllr Slingsby agreed to contact CREATE and confirm this.

Cllr Pollard was also asked to bring up the threat from the Bishop Burton side of the village.

Cllr Smith had been to the last flood prevention meeting which had been interesting. No mention of the new round of funding.
