

Minutes of the meeting of Cherry Burton Parish Council held on Tuesday 11th September 2018 in the Sports Pavilion.

09/18/42 Declarations of Interest
Cllrs Peirson, Dickinson and Wardale for Village Hall.

09/18/43 Minutes of the meeting held on 10th July 2018 were agreed and signed as a complete record.

09/18/44 Matters Arising

Salt Bin on Two Riggs

Cllr Wardale reported that ERYC had agreed to return the salt bin on Two Riggs if the PC agreed to take over responsibility for the ongoing maintenance charges. These would be 2 to 3 times per year and cost £41 plus VAT.

There was a discussion about using adjacent bin on Thornleys instead of getting another one there and how this might set a precedent.

Resolved – to ask if ERYC could just top the bin up on demand.

Flooding Issues

Cllr Peirson had had two letters from a resident of Canada Drive about surveying of the drains and flood prevention bund in the village by ERYC.

The resident was concerned that the flood water was draining over into her garden from the bund.

The culvert has been unblocked.

Resolved - Write about water overflowing and ask for the barrier to be raised. Also send survey done in the past. Cllr Peirson agreed to pull a letter together.

Village Walkabout Report

This had been received and was discussed.

The damaged sign at The Meadows/Bishop Burton Road junction pointing to the Sportsfield had not been repaired yet.

Cllr Stanley reported that the apple tree overhanging the snicket between The Meadows/Main Street has been pruned.

Resolved – to report the sign again.

Tree work around village

Emails had been received from residents concerned about the tree work in a garden on Bishop Burton Road. ERYC had been contacted but there were no tree preservation orders in place and could not help.

Bishop Burton Road

A meeting had take place with Mr Sugdon from ERYC to discuss a footpath on Bishop Burton Road. He had suggested that there was space available but no funding.

He suggested asking Rich Alderson and Mark Jessop at ERYC to find out if there were any investments plans for the area.

Resolved - Contact college again about dangers to students.

Resolved - Cllr Baker agreed.

The Village Hall Committee had written to ask for financial support. Cllr Stanley expressed her support for the Hall and its role in village life.

Cllr Baker highlighted the £20,000 already in the Village Hall accounts and felt it would be better to support a specific need rather than have the annual sum. He also felt that the new committee needed to investigate possible funding streams.

Cllr Dickinson highlighted the funding that was allocated to the SFMC, but was reminded that the Pavilion was owned by and therefore the responsibility of the Parish Council and had to be maintained, unlike the Village Hall that was a charity with trustees.

There was a discussion about the best way of supporting the facility, given the possible legal fees that may need to be covered.

Resolved – it was agreed to give the donation that was allocated for 2017/18 and then discuss further donations later.
