Notice of Decision

Erection single storey extension 3 Canada Drive – planning permission granted with conditions.

Erection two agricultural buildings, Cherry Lodge, Malton Road – planning permission refused for the following reasons:-

The proposed buildings would be located in open countryside and would only be allowed if they are genuinely required for agriculture. One of the uses is storage of agricultural machinery which would not be agricultural but commercial.

This would introduce an unacceptable level of harm to the rural character and appearance of the area.
