ERYC Matters

(a) Highway Matters

ERYC Traffic Management department had sent the overall results of the speed survey that had recently been carried out on Bishop Burton Road. Points scored were 2.94, which would come into the “Qualified for local solutions” category.

Resolved - to ask for a further breakdown of the data to include times and speeds.

(b) Climate change survey

This has been circulated with the link for individual councillors to respond if they wish to.

(c) Precept 2022/23

(d) Footpath to Hudson Way from Canada Drive.

Cllr Greenwood had contacted Deborah Smedley (Senior Definitive Map Officer ERYC) about the delays in the re-instatement of the above footpath. She had responded stating that the COVID situation had caused delays, but that the case was being taken up again. There had also been delays with getting landowner permission for two small sections of the path.

Resolved – Cllr Greenwood agreed to write again shortly and to keep it on the agenda.
