

THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

Newbald Lodge Road, Cherry Burton

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Newbald Lodge Road, Cherry Burton starting at the junction with A1079 for 1600m commencing 12th July 2021 to allow works for carriageway works for Openreach underground network.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 12 days.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Newbald Lodge Road, Stoneknowle Hill, Beverley Road, Eastgate, Galegate, Westgate, Sands Top, Beverley Lane, Hessleskew Lane and York Road and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure.

The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians.
