ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
BISHOP BURTON ROAD, CHERRY BURTON

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Bishop Burton Road, Cherry Burton (between Bishop Burton Road to Southbound for 630 metres) commencing Wednesday 2 September 2020 to enable cabling works to restore customer service.

The Road Closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 September 2020.

The alternative route for traffic affected by this closure will be via Cherry Burton Road, Beverley Road, York Road & Highgate.

The road will remain open for Emergency vehicles, access to residents and pedestrians only.
