I am writing this in the middle of what is known in The Church of England as a Kingdom Season; the week or so between Ascension Day and Pentecost. If you don't know or care what that means that's fairly normal for most people as this season doesn't come with cards or gifts or chocolate eggs like the more popular seasons of Christmas or Easter do. It is a time that is difficult to really grasp the significance of as it has been a little lost to the Church and to the British nation generally. In short it is the season to celebrate Jesus returning to the Father to prepare a place for us (Jesus' ascension) and the anointing of the Holy Spirit on the first disciples on the day of Pentecost, which led to hundreds understanding who Jesus was and becoming followers of his way.

The significance of this season is in the inclusivity of it. The kingdom of God as taught and demonstrated by Jesus is for everyone. From the doubters (Thomas) and deniers (Peter) to the faithful and committed (John). Men and women, the poor and rich, the locals and those from far away, are all included in God's kingdom. Over the centuries since these events first took place the Church has often failed to demonstrate the inclusivity of God's kingdom. Instead, we have become exclusive, closed, a holy huddle of those who know they are 'in' and sure of keeping 'out' those they know are undesirables. This exclusivity does not reflect the nature of God in Christ who gave his only begotten son because he loved the whole world.

As Rector of Cherry Burton and Assistant Curate of Etton with Dalton Holme, I desire for the Church to be a place of belonging for everyone. I pray that God's kingdom can be shared and known through the new Open Door Café, through Messy Church, as part of the mixture of Sunday morning worship, by sharing a pint in the pub, or in the numerous other ways people meet and share and are community. You are deeply loved and accepted by a God; freely given the chance to forgive and be forgiven of all the things that separate and divide you from others.

In God's kingdom, by the power of his Holy Spirit and through our openness to be inclusive and included and forgiven we can know real belonging. I pray that reality for us both.
